Nabe'et Kareem

Nabe'et Kareem is a natural spring in Jdeideh near Mukhtara village. The
project was in partnership with EBML and in collaboration with Mr. Walid
Joumblatt who bought the land and suggested the establishment of a
water pumping system so that water could be pumped from the spring to
Moukhtara bridge. A cement tank was built along with a water pumping
station with pipes of 8 inches width.

Trainings with Green Orient

• In 2018 and in cooperation with Green Orient, several trainings and awareness sessions were conducted focusing mainly on farmers and local producers. The trainings were mainly about beekeeping and oregano plantation. 1000 oregano seedlings were distributed on four key farmers.









Souk El Ghalli

 Souk El Ghalli was launched in August 2018 in cooperation with ACS, SIF and the Bakaata Women Organization. Local producers got to market all of their products. This market will again be implemented in 2019 and the coming years.

Other Trainings with SIF


- SIF conducted trainings for women on the methods of drying fruits and making Labneh Serdaleh (shown in the photos below) and other food products prior to the implementation of the market.
- SIF also led several trainings on poultry and beekeeping, and distributed chicken to 14 farmers, each farmer got 24 chicken.
